<p>Christian Leadership Merit Scholarship</p> <p>3.5 grade point average or above</p> <p>Demonstration of leadership and Christian commitment through volunteerism and involvement in ministry</p> <p>Having turned in their re-enrollment form and are current on tuition payments</p>	<p>Christian Leadership Scholarships are awarded to 7th & 8th graders who exemplify Christian characteristics through their actions in volunteering and serving in the church, school and the community while continuing strong academic preparation in school. Students will be nominated on the basis of their leadership levels, and demonstration of Christian commitment. Having maintained a 3.5 grade point average or above based on the student's cumulative performance for the last full year and with current performance assessed at or above that level.</p> <p>Having demonstrated involvement in school organizations and activities</p> <p>Considering volunteerism and involvement in ministry</p> <p>Having strong character based on a review of disciplinary records as contained in the student's grade files and teacher feedback.</p>	<p>The scholarship represents a one-time per year \$200 (per child) offset against the cost of tuition. The number of Leadership Scholarships will vary depending upon availability of scholarship resources. Up to four \$200 scholarships may be awarded.</p>	<p>Awarded at the end of 6th grade year for their 7th grade year provided grade point average is at or above 3.5 and the student is nominated by the school staff. Awarded at the end of 7th grade year for their 8th grade following the same guidelines.</p>
